



FOR BOARD OF RETIREMENT: For the past 23 years I have served on the LACERA Boards as a Trustee. I was first elected to the Board of Retirement in 1997 and have served on either one or both boards ever since. Currently I am the longest serving trustee on either LACERA Board. During my tenure at LACERA I have been elected Chair of the Board of Retirement eleven times and have served on all committees that we have on the Board of Retirement. I did spend a six-year term on the Board of Investments, which ended with my retirement from the Sheriff's Department in December 2004. During my entire tenure on the Board of Retirement I have served on the Insurance, Benefits, and Legislative Committee, and I have been Chairman of this committee nearly every year that I have been on the Board. For the past fifteen years I have written a monthly blog that goes out to over 5,000 retired and active members of LACERA. FOR BOARD OF INVESTMENTS: As the retired Los Angeles County Treasurer-Tax Collector/Public Administrator (TTC/PA), I am capable, committed and credentialed.
